

Can persons with felony convictions **VOTE IN WASHINGTON?**

YES.

You *automatically* regain the right to vote when you have completed incarceration and any required Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) community custody. Your right to vote is restored upon meeting these conditions even if you still owe legal financial obligations (LFOs).
