12	the papers, records, and files in these consolidated actions, and being fully advised, the Court
13	ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:
14	With regard to preliminary or procedural motions:

- 2. With regard to Motions for Summary Judgment:
 - a. The Court finds that there is no dispute of material fact and the parties are entitled to judgment as a matter of law as described in this Order and in the Court's oral ruling of August 29, 2014;
 - b. Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is DENIED; and
 - c. Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment is GRANTED IN PART, and the Court makes the following declarations:
 - i. The City of Fife's Ordinance 1872 is not preempted by state law;
 - ii. Having concluded that Ordinance 1872 is not preempted by state law, this Court enters no ruling as to whether provisions of state law enacted through Initiative 502 are, or are not, preempted by federal law; and
- 3. Based upon these conclusions, the Court DENIES Plaintiffs' requests for declaratory and injunctive relief and writ of mandamus;
- 4. The Court does not reach Plaintiffs' challenge to the manner in which Defendant City of Fife enacted Ordinance 1872, including Plaintiffs' estoppel argument, and this issue remains pending before this Court;
- 5. The Court also does not reach Plaintiffs' takings argument, and this issue remains pending before this Court; and
- 6. The Court certifies that this Order involves a controlling question of law as to which there is substantial ground for a difference of opinion and that immediate review of the order may materially advance the ultimate termination of the litigation.
- 7. Pursuant to CR 54(b) and RAP 2.2(d), the Court makes the following findings: The Court concludes that Fife Ordinance No. 1872 is not expressly preempted by state

law. The Court finds that while RCW 69.50.608 prohibits Fife from imposing penalties for violations of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act different than those specified by the Act, it does not prevent Fife from enacting ordinances allowing imposition of penalties for zoning or business operation violations under its municipal code, including complete bans on local business licenses for marijuana production, processing, and retailing. The Court concludes that Fife Ordinance No. 1872 does not violate Washington State Constitution Art. XI, § 11. The Court concludes that there is no irreconcilable conflict between state law and Fife Ordinance No. 1872. The Court finds that while I-502 permits retail cannabis operations to be located throughout the state, and allows the Liquor Control Board to grant permits throughout the state, I-502 does not require that retail marijuana stores be located in Fife. In addition, the Court finds that the Liquor Control Board, in contrast to determining that there could be 31 retail outlets located in Pierce County, did not specifically allocatedary licenses for operations in Fife.
