SUMMONS (20 Days)

TO: KING COUNTY, Defendant; and

TO: KING COUNTY EXECUTIVE DOW CONSTANTINE, Defendant:

1. A lawsuit has been started against you in the above entitled court by The American Civil Liberties Union of Washington Foundation (Plaintiff).

2. Plaintiff's claims are stated in the written Complaint, a copy of which is served upon you with this summons, the order setting case schedule, and the case information cover sheet.

3. In order to defend against this lawsuit, you must respond to the Complaint by stating your defense in writing, and by serving a copy upon the undersigned person within twenty (20) days after the service of this summons, excluding the day of service, or a default

1 judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default judgment is one where the
2 plaintiff is entitled to what he asks for because you have not responded.

3 4. If you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned person, you are entitled to
4 notice before a default judgment may be entered.

5 5. If not previously filed, you may demand that the Plaintiff file this lawsuit with the
6 court. If you do so, the demand must be in writing and must be served upon the undersigned
7 person. Within fourteen (14) days after you serve your demand, the plaintiff must file this
8 lawsuit with the court, or the service on you of this Summons and Complaint will be void.

9 6. If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so
10 promptly so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.

11 This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 4 of the Superior Court Civil Rules of the State
12 of Washington.
