DECLARATION OF KEITH ORCHARD IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

I, Keith Orchard, hereby declare as follows:

1. I have lived in the Puget Sound area since 1962.

2. I enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1968 and worked in personnel and administration. I served in Vietnam in 1969. I was honorably discharged in 1971 as a Corporal.

3. I joined Veterans for Peace, Greater Seattle, Chapter 92 ("VFP 92") in 2008. After I got out of the Marines, I studied the issue of war and peace and became anti-war.

4. I marched in the Auburn Veterans Day Parade with VFP 92 in 2010 and 2011. I think marching in the parade is important because it makes people aware that there are veterans who are opposed to war. It is a powerful statement that one can be opposed to war and still be patriotic citizens and support veterans.
