DECLARATION OF PHILIP HEFT IN
SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER AND PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION

I, Philip Heft, hereby declare as follows:

1. From 1953 to 1957, I was on active duty in the Air Force as a weather officer in the Air Weather Service. I was in the Air Force Reserves from 1957 until 1965, when I was honorably discharged. I received the National Defense Medal.

2. I joined Veterans for Peace, Greater Seattle, Chapter 92 ("VFP 92") in 2003 because I was very opposed to militarism and was concerned about the increasing militarism of our country. I have been an active member, serving as both Vice President and Director-at-Large on the VFP 92 Board of Directors.

3. I have marched with VFP 92 in the Auburn Veterans Day Parade for five years. Marching in the parade is important because it gives people to chance to see that there are
